Henry Vestine joined the Canned Heat Jug Band formed by two blues record collector fanatics, Bob Hite and Al Wilson in 1965, who shortened their name to Canned Heat upon Henry joining. Canned Heat played Monterey Pop Festival in 1967 and had the hits 'On The Road Again' & 'Goin' Up The Country'. After which he left the band for the first of many times due to a reported dispute with other band members over his drug intake at a show at The Fillmore in San Francisco just days before the Woodstock Music Festival in 1969. When Henry Vestine played on stage out came the monster. "The Wildman", as he was called, the guitar player who could often only be stopped on a solo by the entire band coming back in on the vocal part of the song (and even then it could be hard to stop him). He played with fire and passion as if his own life depended on every single solo he took. He could sound like a Gonzo LSD trip gone into the farthest reaching limits of the human experience or he could be completely disciplined. He was the embodiment of the living bluesman, the true spirit of that great band that was once Canned Heat.
