OVERVIEW:

- Living legend, began his recording career at the height of the Blue Note Records heyday in the 1960s
- Pivotal member of Miles Davis' second great quintet and also his early fusion efforts (In A Silent Way & Bitches Brew)
- Pioneered Fusion Jazz and Funk Jazz
- •Pioneered (along with Miles Davis) mainstream Jazz film scoring (Blow Up, Death Wish, Round Midnight,etc)
- Had major hit records with "Chameleons" (1970s) and "Rock-It" (1980s)
- · Still active today as Jazz' great elder statesman
