Soul Music's definitive duo. Sam & Dave's non-stop, call and response fervid frantic singing and live shows remain legendary, and their recordings contain some of Soul music's finest moments!

They started out in Miami in 1961, when Dave Prater entered into an amateur contest that Sam Moore was emceeing and became popular in the Miami region, and were subsequently signed to Roulette Records, and then to the Atlantic label, who recorded them at the Stax Studios in Memphis, where the songwriters Isaac Hayes and David Porter began writing the songs that Sam & Dave would make into legendary hits utilising their emotional singing style.

Their first hit was "You Don't Know Like I Know" (#7 R&B 1966), followed by the smash "Hold On I'm Coming" (#1 R&B #21 Pop 1966) then "Said I wasn't Gonna Tell Nobody" (#8 R&B) and "You Got Me Hummin'" (#7 R&B) to round out the year. In 1967, they had their biggest hits with "When Something Is Wrong With My Baby" (#2 R&B) and "Soul Man" (#2 Pop #1 R&B) then "I Thank You" (#4 R&B #7 Pop) in 1969. In 1970 "Soul Sister, Brown Sugar" (#18 R&B #41 Pop) was their last hit, and they broke up for the first of many times in 1970. In 1992 Sam & Dave were inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall Of Fame. Dave Prater was killed in a car crash in 1988. Sam Moore continues to sing and perform live. His most recent success being his duet with Conway Twitty singing "Raining Night In Georgia" on 1994's "country and Rhythm & Blues" CD. Sam Moore remains, in the opinion of many artists and critics in the music industry, one of the finest vocalists in the entire history of recorded music.
