Soul Blues singer Z.Z. Hill (born Azell Hill) was one of the foundation artists for the southernstyled soul-blues phenomenon, and was responsible for resurrecting interest in the Blues with southern black audiences, through his Malaco release "Down Home Blues", which charted for an incredible 100 weeks on the Billboard R&B charts between 1983 and 1984. Although Hill was little known to white listeners, his popularity at the time amongst Black listeners was even greater than B.B. King. Hill's mix of R&B, Soul and Blues singing was reminiscent of Bobby "Blue" Bland and Johnny Taylor. He recorded for a number of labels including his brother's label MHR, Kent, Hill, United Artists, CBS (who had him recording disco!), and Malaco. Z. Z. Hill had a number of hits over the years including I Need Someone (To Love Me), Down Home Blues, Don't Make Me Pav For This Mistake etc.

Sadly, at the peak of his popularity, Z. Z. Hill was involved in a car accident, and as a result of complications from injuries he received, died of a blood clot on April 27, 1984.
