Willie Nelson is a true outlaw, and probably the greatest legend and performer in country music since Hank Williams.

He was born Willie Hugh Nelson on April 30, 1933 in Abbot, Texas, and following his mother's desertion, and the death of his father, Willie and his sister Bobbie were raised by their grandparent who encouraged Willie to play the guitar.

They say he was writing songs as early as seven years old, anyway Willie's first record "Lumberjack" was released when he was 23 years old.

Willie moved to Nashville in 1960, and started writing songs and making a name for himself in the music community there when major country artists started to get hits with them. Ray Price did "Nightlife", Faron Young did "Hello Walls", Patsy Cline did "Crazy" and Jimmy Elledge did "Funny How Time Slips Away" (the majority of these songs are on Aim 3003 Willie Nelson - 23 Of His Best Vol 1).

The songs on this recording were recorded by Willie as songwriter demos in the early 60's, just before he signed with the Liberty label. At that time he was considered more of a songwriter than a performer, some of his critics have said Willie talks rather than sings his millions of fans will strongly disagree.

Accordingly, there is a sparse feel to these recordings, which in some cases feature only Willie with his voice and guitar. But really, if you like Willie Nelson, then you already know, there is absolutely nothing wrong with that. Over the years Willie has re-recorded many of these songs with lush arrangements, and for many of his fans, they just don't compare with the minimal backing on these recordings.
